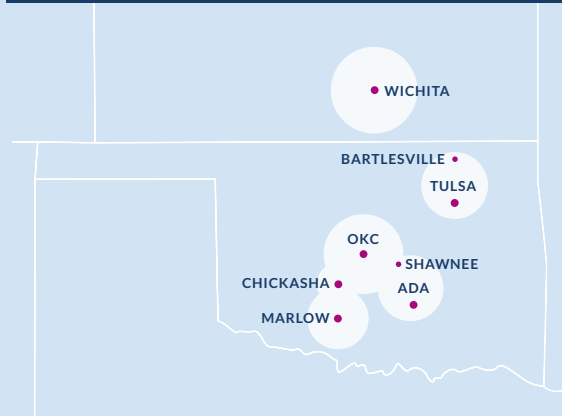

FAQs

What is Hospice?

Hospice is not a facility; instead care is provided where the patient lives, at home or in a long-term care setting. Hospice provides a care team including nurse, social work, chaplain, volunteers and medical director to provide 24/7 care support to help control physical and emotional pain to assure the patient's comfort and dignity.

When should a decision about entering a hospice program be made and who should make it?

At any time during a life-limiting illness, it's appropriate to discuss all of a patient's care options, including hospice. By law the decision belongs to the patient. Most hospices accept patients who have a life-expectancy of six months.

Does hospice do anything to make death come sooner?

Hospice neither hastens nor postpones dying. Just as doctors and midwives lend support and expertise during the time of child birth, hospice provides its presence and knowledge during the dying process.

How does hospice manage pain?

Hospice believes that emotional pain is just as real as physical pain, so it addresses each. Hospice nurses and doctors are up to date on the latest medications and devices for pain and symptom relief. Counselors, including clergy, are available to assist family members as well as patients.

Is hospice care covered by insurance?

Hospice coverage is widely available. It is provided by Medicare nationwide and by most private insurance providers.

CLINICAL
